The North Collin Special Utility District ("NCSUD" or "District") Board of Directors will hold a Board of Directors' meeting on Thursday, September 15, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. at NCSUD office at 2333 Sam Rayburn Hwy., Melissa, TX 75454. This meeting will be held in accordance with the following:

Agenda

1. Call to order and Roll Call.
2. Hear public comments. (The NCSUD Board will hear public comments for items not listed on the agenda, but any discussion shall be limited to the item being placed on a future agenda for further consideration or, if appropriate, direct the speaker to District staff for more information. Limit individual comments to three minutes with a maximum of fifteen minutes total for public comments.)
3. Discuss and take appropriate action regarding merger between North Collin SUD and Altoga WSC, including but not limited to the following:
 - a. Discuss and take action to adopt Ordinance No. 2022-005, providing for the addition of one (1) director to the District's Board of Directors in accordance with the Transfer Agreement by and between Altoga Water Supply Corporation and the District and authorizing the District to be governed by a board of six (6) directors; providing for severability, conflicts and savings, and an effective date.
 - b. Discuss and take appropriate action regarding appointment of additional Board of Director member.
4. Presentation by NewGen Strategies and Solutions. Discuss and take appropriate action regarding the District's water rate study as prepared by Newgen Strategies and Solutions.
5. Recess into Executive Session according to Tex. Gov't Code Section 551.071-Private consultation with the District's attorney for North Collin Special Utility District and Section 551.072 Discussing purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property in regards to the following:
